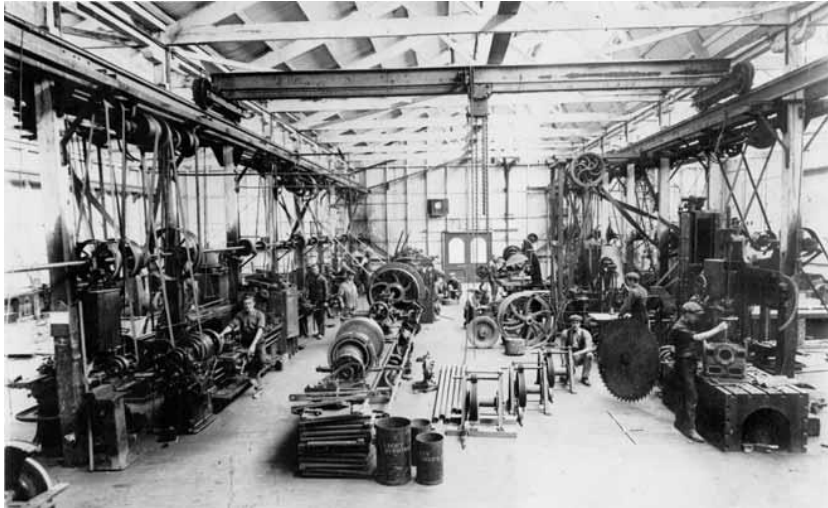


History and Heritage

Alucor, a leading Engineering, Procurement, and Construction (EPC) company, has been serving a wide range of industries since its establishment in 1991.



In 1991, Alucor was founded by Mr. Suresh Bhatia, commencing its journey by offering engineering and maintenance services to the marine industry with just 8 dedicated employees. The year 1999 marked a significant expansion as the company ventured into specialized services with CNC equipment. In 2005, a pivotal moment saw the establishment of a sprawling 30,000 sqm workshop in Dubai, accompanied by a remarkable growth in the workforce, which surpassed 250 employees.

The year 2007 marked another milestone when Alucor was entrusted with its first mechanical installation project, awarded by the UAE's largest aluminum producer, DUBAL. By 2015, the company achieved an EPC project accolade for the production of 280 Jacketed Pipe Units for an Alumina Refinery, a venture that saw its workforce soar to 975.

In 2017, Alucor expanded its footprint by establishing an entity in the Kingdom of Bahrain, growing its total workforce to over 1300. The year 2020 witnessed the execution of turnkey EPC projects across the Middle East, leading to a substantial increase in manpower to 1800.

The company's trajectory continued to soar in 2021, with the establishment of an additional presence in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, where it secured a project in Jubail for the construction of a desalination plant. And as of 2023, Alucor has continued its legacy by securing projects in KSA for the construction of a 900 MW gas-fired power plant and a 150 MIGD Desalination Plant, further solidifying its position as a leading player in the industry.
